

Board Member Qualifications

The qualifications for any Board Member will be as follows:

- A) A PCSA Active Member of the Association for at least three (3) years;
- B) Be an owner, manager, or supervisor of an PCSA "Active Member" Facility for at least three (3) years;
- C) Be willing and able to attend two (2) Board meetings annually;
- D) Is a Certified Kennel Operator (CKO) or currently enrolled in PCSA's Education Program to achieve the status of CKO within three (3) years of being appointed or elected.
- E) In addition, all Board Members shall:
 - (i) Believe in the principle of trade associations and the value of their contribution to industry.
 - (ii) Desire to serve others working in the same industry and to help strengthen the industry as a whole.
 - (iii) Believe non-veterinary pet care services are honorable professions.
 - (iv) Sign a statement, when volunteering for or accepting the nomination for the position, that they:
 - a) Meet these qualifications for the position;
 - b) Understand the responsibilities and duties of the position;
 - c) Are willing and able, if elected, to perform the functions of a Board Member, and
 - d) If and when they are not able to meet the qualifications or carry out the required duties of the Board of Directors, will submit their resignation from the position.
 - f) All Board Members of PCSA must be pet care facility owners or managers that are currently employed by an PCSA member facility. In the event that a director no longer qualifies for the position due to a change in employment or ownership status, the director must immediately inform the CGO and the office.
