#### Dr. E. J. Finocchio

Dr. Finocchio DVM was a practicing equine veterinarian for 33 years in Rhode Island. He is currently the 10<sup>th</sup> director of the Rhode Island SPCA. He is a children's book author and illustrator making his debut with Marvelous Marvin. Check out his website at www.marvindfund.org.

#### Marvin

Marvelous Marvin is based on a true story. Marvin is now a four-year-old Black Labrador that was relinquished to the RISPCA by his original owner who no longer had time for him after 3 ½ years. He was born on a farm in Maryland, being the runt of a litter of nine. As a young pup, Marvin's right hind leg was injured and he required surgery. The injury left him permanently lame. He was adopted out soon after being given up by his original owner, only to be returned once again to the RISPCA because of his lameness. If you look closely, he does have a few white hairs where he was injured.

Because of his tremendous personality, gentleness, loyalty and intelligence, not to mention his soft drooping velvety ears and piercing brown eyes, Dr. Finocchio and the RISPCA adopted Marvin.

Marvin now shares his time at the RISPCA greeting people, participating in the humane education program for children, visiting nursing homes, rehabilitation hospitals and at Dr. Finocchio's farm chasing geese, following the scent of a deer, playing in the brook or creating MarvArt, his original water color paintings.
